I need help with rent, utilities, or staying in my current housing:

- Contact the Housing Resource Line: (804) 422-5061. The Housing Resource Line is a new resource to help you gain access to essential housing services. The Housing Resource Line can help with financial assistance, emergency assistance, and foreclosure prevention, among other resources.

I am in need of emergency shelter:

- Contact the Homeless Connection Line: (804) 972-0813. The Homeless Connection Line facilitates access to resources and shelter alternatives for those who are three days or less away from losing their housing. This line is also available for those already experiencing homelessness.
